A note on JSTOR accounts: Users who create or log in to a personal account while authenticated will automatically have their accounts paired with their institutions. Individuals with paired accounts can use their accounts to access JSTOR for 120 days from anywhere. Learn more about <u>JSTOR account pairing</u>.
